## Things God Can't Do, Part 3—God Can't Stop Loving You

### Romans 8:35-39

There are at least two key things we must understand:

#1 - Paul is talking about God's love for us, not our love for God. God's love and passion for us never dissipates. It is God's love for us that Paul is declaring from Romans chapter eight.

#2 - Six times throughout this paragraph, Paul uses either the word "us" or "we." Who is he talking about? He is talking about believers, saved people. The answer to the question, "Who can separate us from God's love?" is directed toward those you have accepted Christ as their personal Savior.

"Can tribulation separate you from God's love? No."

"Can distress separate you from God's love? No."

"Can the sword separate you from God's love? No."
