

## JUDGMENTS of the APOCALYPSE THE DAWN OF ETERNITY

Sermon Fourteen: The Dawn Of Eternity

Revelation 21-22

#1 - A <u>Fresh</u> Start, Revelation 21:1, 4-5, 22:3

{read Revelation 21:1, 4-5, 22:3}

There is clearly some sense in which the book of Revelation now declares that God dwells uniquely among men, the text adding several observations:

First, God himself will be with them (v. 3).

Second, he will wipe away every tear from their eyes (v. 4).

Third, death will be abolished (v. 4).

Fourth, as a result, there shall be no more mourning or crying (v. 4).

Fifth, the curse upon humanity and all God's original creation will be wiped away, (22:3)

## #2 - The Heavenly City, Revelation 21:2-3, 9-26, 22:1

We have the most detailed picture of what Heaven looks like within these verses.

## {read Revelation 21:2-3, 9-26, 22:1}

This is the dwelling place of God. Unlike at any other time in human history, the dwelling place of God will hover above the new earth.

According to this passage, the city is enormous in both value and size:

- It's a walled-city, with a wall surrounding the city that is 216 feet thick.
- The city itself, has 12 gates, bearing the names of the 12 tribes of Israel.
- The walls of the city are founded upon 12 foundation stones which bear the names of the 12 apostles.
- The dimensions of the city are approx. 1,400 miles long and 1,400 miles high.
- The materials used to construct the city are of precious stones and pure gold.
